See if you can spot the lie in each set!

## SET 1

1. John performed miracles to prove his authority.
2. John called the crowd "a brood of vipers."
3. John warned the crowds to produce fruit in keeping with repentance.



## SET 2

1. John told tax collectors not to collect more than they were authorized to.
2. John told soldiers to stop serving in the military.
3. John told people to share their clothing and food with others.

## SET 3

1. John baptized with the Holy Spirit and fire.
2. John said he was not worthy to untie the straps of the Messiah's sandals.
3. John said the Messiah would baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire.



## SET 4

1. John predicted that the Messiah would gather the wheat and burn the chaff.
2. John was afraid to speak against Herod's sins.
3. John rebuked Herod for taking his brother's wife.

## SET 5

1. Jesus was baptized by John.
2. The Holy Spirit descended on Jesus in the form of a dove.
3. John refused to baptize Jesus.



## SET 6

1. Jesus began his ministry immediately after being baptized.
2. Jesus was about 30 years old when he began his ministry.
3. A voice from heaven said, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."

## SET 7

1. Jesus' genealogy in Luke 3 traces his lineage back to Adam.
2. Jesus' genealogy in Luke 3 includes King David.
3. Jesus' genealogy in Luke 3 begins with Abraham.



## SET 8

1. John the Baptist told people to prepare the way for the Lord.
2. John the Baptist was imprisoned by Herod.
3. John the Baptist witnessed Jesus being tempted in the wilderness.

## SET 9

1. The crowds asked John what they should do to repent.
2. John said the Messiah would bring peace to everyone.
3. John warned that the Messiah would come with a winnowing fork in his hand.



## SET 10

1. John the Baptist rebuked people who relied on being descendants of Abraham.
2. The Holy Spirit appeared as a fire over Jesus at his baptism.
3. Jesus' baptism was accompanied by a voice from heaven.
