SET 1

SET 2

2. Simon told Jesus he was not a sinner.
3. Simon caught so many fish that his nets began to break.

SET 3

2. Jesus told Simon he would fish for people.
3. Simon, James, and John left everything to follow Jesus.



SET 4

1. A man with leprosy asked Jesus to heal him.
2. Jesus avoided crowds and refused to heal them.
3. Jesus often withdrew to lonely places to pray.

SET 5

1. A paralyzed man was lowered through the roof to see Jesus.
2. Jesus forgave the man's sins before healing him.
3. The Pharisees praised Jesus for forgiving sins.



SET 6

1. Jesus healed the paralyzed man to prove His authority to forgive sins.
2. The crowd was angry that Jesus healed the man.
3. The paralyzed man walked home, praising God.

SET 7

1. Jesus called Levi (Matthew), a tax collector, to follow Him.
2. Levi held a great banquet for Jesus.
3. The Pharisees praised Jesus for eating with tax collectors.



SET 8

1. Jesus said fasting was required to follow Him.
2. Jesus said the righteous didn't need repentance.
3. Jesus said He came to call sinners to repentance.

SET 9

1. The Pharisees asked Jesus why His disciples did not fast.
2. Jesus said His disciples would fast when He was taken away.
3. Jesus told the Pharisees to fast twice a week.



SET 10

1. Jesus compared Himself to a bridegroom.
2. Jesus said new wine must be poured into new wineskins.
3. Jesus said old wine was better than new wine.
